Date:— 8th October, 1952.

The Owners state that the donkey boiler will not be used unless the vessel should at some time be laid up.

They therefore propose that the class of the boiler should be allowed to lapse and that, should it be desired to use the boiler at some future date, a complete survey should be carried out before it is placed in service.
