

This is to Certify that I have surveyed part of the machinery of the S.S. "YOUSUFBAKSH" 5975 Gross tons of KARACHI for Advancement of ES and Commencement of MBS, whilst lying afloat at Chittagong on the 23rd February, 1965, and subsequently,

and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following

survey records assigned ES (with date) when the survey has been completed, and MBS 2.65, when the starboard boiler has been examined in entirety, the safety valves of all main boilers have been adjusted under steam, the oil burning and remote controls examined working, subject to the main condenser forward door being renewed on arrival at Bombay, where now bound and to ~~Parts now examined:-~~ the wasted forward water box of the lubricating oil cooler and wasted suction valve chest of the General Service Pump being renewed before the end of June, 1965, and to any outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.

Parts now examined:-

Port and Starboard boilers in entirety with all valves, safety valves and mountings.

For ES:

Main Engine MP Astern eccentric sheave and strap.
All Intermediate shafts and bearings.
Independent General Service Pump.
Lubricating Oil Cooler.
Steam Auxiliary Engine for Circulating Pump.
