In reply to your memorandum of the 2nd June I have to say that the requirements of a General Examination have been partly complied with during the advancement of the Special Survey, and to complete this inspection the holds and 'tween decks, machinery spaces, structure below boilers, fore and after peak spaces, main and auxiliary steering gear and the windlass require inspection. As regards the machinery a complete General Examination requires to be held or the Engine Survey advanced by the inspection of the electrical installation, pumping arrangements and the engine working and manoeuvring. Provided that all these requirements are dealt with at a very early date, the Committee will then be prepared to consider the postponement of the completion of the Special Survey at Hamburg in September next as proposed.

I shall be glad if you will advise the Owners accordingly, and let me know as soon as possible what arrangements are proposed for the General Examination of the hull and machinery to be dealt with.
