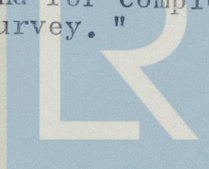
ANSWER

Date:— 17. 3. 65.

Regret my reply of the 23rd February, 1965, has probably been delayed by the now finished postal strike in East Pakistan. The Owners are unable to give any further information to that contained in my memo of the above date.

This memo read as follows:

"The Owners' Agents have informed me that since completing discharging cargo in Chittagong in October, 1964 the ship has been laid up pending completion of Government formalities. They are unable to advise me regarding the arrangements for supplying 30 fathoms chain cable, and for completing the Main Boiler Survey. "
