I enclose for your information and guidance, a copy of the Owners' letter of the 3rd May, together with a copy of my reply of today's date, and shall be glad if you will give the case the required attention if the General Examination in drydock and other surveys referred to in this communication <sup>are</sup> held at your Port.

For your own information, I have to add that, in view of our experience with ships more than 20 years old, the Committee are prepared to agree to the postponement of the Special Survey only after a very thorough General Examination of the hull has been held in accordance with the Terms of Circular No. 1959, including an internal examination of any water ballast deep tanks, by the due date of the Special Survey. You should therefore be guided accordingly, paying special attention to the possibility of grooving at the heel of frames and wastage of bilge shell plating and structure in way. The period of postponement for the Special Survey is to be dependent upon the condition of the ship as found at the General Examination.
