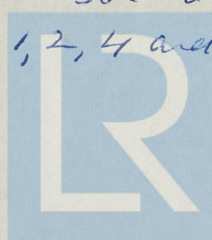
1. M.E. lub. oil cooler water box being examined and dealt with by $\frac{1}{65}$.

5. Port Ford aux. engine No. 4 entablature ($\frac{M}{L}$ $\frac{10}{64}$) being examined by $\frac{4}{65}$ (6 months limit).
