Reports of surveys held at Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne and Adelaide in September and October have now received the consideration of the Committee.

As a result of these surveys class has been continued subject, inter alia, to:-

1. The starboard main engine No.4 centre top end bearings being examined and dealt with by the end of December 1964.
2. The inboard main air compressor M.P. cooler body being renewed by the end of January 1965.
3. The port forward auxiliary engine No.4 entablature (Metalocked 10.64) being examined by the end of April 1965.
