Following the survey carried out by the Society's Liverpool Surveyors between the 13th and 21st July, fresh records of Docking Survey 7.64 and Auxiliary Boiler Survey 3.64 have been assigned, and the Committee have continued the vessel's class subject to set up and indented keel plates Nos. 8 and 9 from aft being specially examined and dealt with as necessary next drydocking, and to the Main Engine lubricating oil cooler lower water box being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the end of January 1965.

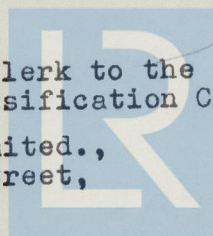
According to the records in this Office the following machinery items have not been seen for more than four years, and it will be appreciated if you will make the necessary arrangements for these items to be surveyed at an early date.

Port aft auxiliary engine
