Single Screw Hopper Dredger "STAN WOOLAWAY"

The First Entry Reports on the survey of this barge during construction have been received from Rotterdam, but assignment of class is being withheld pending receipt of reports of the satisfactory condition of the ship on arrival at her destination.

The vessel is to be classed #100A1 Hopper Dredger "For service in the Bristol Channel" "Fitted for carrying and pumping sand", and it is concluded that the requisite inspection will take place in your district and the receipt of your report on the case is awaited, in due course.

At the same time I have to refer to the letter addressed to you by the Rotterdam Surveyors dated 10th December last and inform you that should the electrical inspection not yet have been complied with, it is concluded this matter will receive attention when the above Condition Survey is carried out. Meanwhile, the class has been made subject to a voltage regulator being supplied and fitted to the main engine driven dynamo.
