R. F. A. WAVE MONARCH - Leakage

R. F. A. WAVE MONARCH has reported leakage of cargo from Nos. 2 and 5 port wing tanks; the ship is due at H.M. Oil Fuel Depot, Old Kilpatrick, near Glasgow, for discharge on 19th June 1949.
