S A Representative of the Admiralty has telephoned this afternoon that there is some loss of cargo from Nos. 2 and 5 port wing tanks of this ship. She is proceeding to the Clyde where she is expected to arrive next Sunday and the Admiralty desire an inspection to be made of these tanks while discharging in order to ascertain the cause of the loss of oil.

The Admiralty have been requested to instruct their local representative to contact you as to when a Surveyor is required to attend, but should you not hear from him at an early date it is suggested you should get in touch with the Deputy Naval Store Officer, Oil Fuel Section, Old Kilpatrick, so that there may be no unnecessary delay in the Surveyor attending.

Your records will show that this ship is now classed with the Society as a result of Glasgow Report No. 74046.
