## "GLOUCESTER"

In compliance with Mr. Sutcliffe's telephone call today, I would inform you that the Committee will be prepared to maintain this ship in class until the 31st October, provided she is generally inspected at the Survey that will be necessary for the extension of the Loadline Certificate before the 28th June. The extent of that Survey will be left to the Surveyors discretion, but they will be expected especially to bear in mind the outstanding qualifications of class.

So far as the refrigerating machinery is concerned, a Loading Port Survey should be held if the Running Survey is not completed by September next, and the ship is to carry a refrigerated cargo.
