Motorvessel "GLOUCESTER"

Reverting to your letter dated the 30th June last, and previous correspondence, I have to inform you that the Reports covering the General Examination carried out by the Society's London Surveyors between the 26th July and 9th September, have now received the consideration of the Committee.

In view of the satisfactory nature of this examination, the Committee are agreeable to the Special Survey being postponed until the end of July 1966.

In the meantime, fresh notations of Continuous Survey of the machinery 9,65, Screwshaft Survey 8,65, Auxiliary Boiler Survey 8,65, together with a fresh record of Docking Survey 8,65 have been assigned, and the Committee have continued the vessel's class subject only to indented shell plate J.1 (port side forward) and internals in way, wasted bulkheads 1/2 and 2/3 in way of upper 'tween deck and No. 4 upper 'tween deck chocks and shell plate C.14 (port side) in way of No. 5 lower hold (doubled) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the Special Survey.
