Motorship "CONSULATE" ex "GLOUCESTER"

The Reports of the General Examination held at Hull between the 6th and 22nd June have now received the consideration of the Committee, and in view of the satisfactory nature of this inspection postponement of the Special Survey until October 1966 has been approved.

The class is subject as follows:

1. The indented shell plate J.1 (port side forward) and internals in way, to wasted bulkheads 1/2 and 2/3 in way of upper 'tween deck and to No.4 upper 'tween deck chocks and shell plate C.14 (port side) in way of No.5 lower hold (doubled) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the Special Survey.
2. The stem and stem plating being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking.

I shall be glad to learn your intentions regarding the Auxiliary Boiler Survey, which becomes due at the end of the present month.

Your intentions regarding the Special Survey will be appreciated in due course.
