In reply to your letter of the 28th January, I am pleased to inform you that the Committee are agreeable to the proposed General Examination in drydock at Montreal in July/August next with a view to the postponement of the Special Survey until some time before the end of July 1966.

As regards the machinery, the Continuous Survey cycle should be completed by about July next or, alternatively, a General Examination be held and the items marked with a cross on the attached list examined. The complete list indicates all the items outstanding for completion of the cycle by the end of July next.

There is no objection to a similar postponement of the Special RMC Survey should this be desired.

I take this opportunity to remind you that an Auxiliary Boiler Survey becomes due at the end of March next and that the starboard forward auxiliary engine No.6 water jacket bedplate crankcase requires to be examined by the end of May 1965.

It is concluded that the Screwshaft Survey, due at the end of October next, will be dealt with at the forthcoming drydocking in Montreal.
