As recommended except that class has been continued subject to repairs to Main Engine No.4 unit "A" frame, diaphragm plate and crankcase being specially examined by the end of June 1964 and repairs to the water jacket, bedplate and crankcase in way of No.6 unit of starboard forward generator engine being specially examined by the end of June 1964. It is not understood why you made no recommendations regarding re-examination of the Main Engine and the starboard forward generator engine in view of the nature of the repairs effected.

"VEGALAND". I acknowledge your letter dated 13th December and arrangements have been made for a correction to be made in the Register Book.
