I have to confirm the intimation given you over the telephone this afternoon to the effect that the report of survey held during construction on the Refrigerating Machinery and Appliances of the new Motorship "GLOUCESTER" has now been received from the Glasgow Office.

It appears therefrom that to complete the survey the cooling and insulation tests require to be held and I have the pleasure to say that on satisfactory completion of this work the installation will be eligible for the record of "Lloyd's RMC 7,41" and official Certificates will then be issued accordingly.

In the meantime the Glasgow Surveyors have issued an Interim Certificate, dated the 11th instant, to the effect that they have recommended that a record of "RMC, with date" should be made in the Register Book upon satisfactory completion of the cooling and insulation tests.
