I duly received your letter of the 17th March and have to acquaint you that your remarks regarding the forwarding of your outstanding reports have been carefully noted.

As regards the "ESSO PEDERNALES", "ESSO BOSCAN" and "ESSO MARACAY", I think it well to inform you that it is not the Committee's practice to insert in the Register Book the notation "Laid up - Surveys overdue" until the year of grace for the Special Survey has expired.

In these particular cases the outstanding surveys at the present time are drydocking and Boiler Surveys, and as stated in my letter of the 21st January the Committee have agreed to these inspections remaining in abeyance on the understanding that they will be dealt with before the ships are again placed in service.
