
Steam Trawler "ISERNIA"

We are obliged to you for your letter of the 24th November furnishing information for the Chief Engineer Surveyor's Records Department.

The letter has now reached this Department and we do not understand why up to the 24th November you had not visited the ship without waiting to be called, knowing that she is classed with this Society and was towed to a Port in your district following a fire in the boiler room, which will in all probability necessitate repairs which must be done under survey.

If the ship is not already under inspection it is considered you should communicate with the Owners or their Agents and arrange to visit the trawler at an early opportunity.
