In reply to your letter of the 22nd November, 1965 regarding the above trawler now at Peterhead, we have to advise you of what little we know, as we have not been called upon to attend, nor does it appear that we will be called.

The owners representative, Grimsby Mutual Surveyor and the B.O.T. Surveyor are all in attendance.

From what I can gather at the moment, it appears that the fire started in the stokehold whilst blowing the boiler tubes.

The smoke-box doors seem to have been an indifferent fit and sparks passed to either a generator or the O.F. unit in the stokehold, around which there was oil, which ignited.

With no one in the stokehold during this operation, the fire seemed to get a good grip before being discovered.

I shall endeavour to get further information as time passes, and if anything further comes to light, it will be passed to you.
