This ship was built in 1940-7.

A Special Survey (D) became due 10.65.

Ship last examined in drydock 11.63,

There is an S.R.L. Appendix item.

The notation of "Class Suspended 4.65 - Surveys Overdue" was posted in the R.B. 26.11.65.

The CHITTAGONG Surveyors report 12.65, ship examined afloat on account damage - side shell plating and framing port aft found damaged but not dealt with and temporary repairs (cement boxes) effected.

A number of after deck beams found wasted and holed.

The Committee agreed 11.66 for ship to sail one voyage Chittagong to Karachi as ~~Unclassed~~ ship provided cargo non perishable and ~~does~~ not exceed 2000tons provided a satisfactory General Examination is held and the Surveyors are fully ~~satisfied~~ with her condition.

The CHITTAGONG Surveyors report 11.66, ship examined afloat and found in satisfactory condition to proceed as an ~~Unclassed~~ ship direct to Karachi with no more than 2000 tons of non perishable cargo on board.

On account of damaged due to contact, side shell plating (p.midships), forecastle side and deck plating etc. (p) and side shell plating etc. in way of transom (s) set in and buckled - temporary repairs effected.

The KARACHI Surveyors, in a letter dated 14.1.67 state the ship has arrived at Karachi and earlier proposals made by Owners for carrying out the Special Survey have been abandoned and they ~~now~~ understand the ship will be sold to the shipbreakers at Karachi within the next few months.

IT IS SUBMITTED no further ACTION need be taken pending receipt of further information as to the ship's ultimate disposal.
