ANSWER


Date:- 24th August, 1965

Owners state that the ship due to unforeseen circumstances is held up at Chittagong.

It is expected that she will sail from that port to Karachi by the middle of September, 1965.

After discharging cargo at Karachi the ship would be drydocked at this port, as stated, by the end of October, 1965 and the screwshaft survey carried out.

It is further stated that the repairs to forward boiler would receive attention before the ship sails from Chittagong.
