18061 "ITOLA" This vessel has today been classed #100A1, With freeboard, subject to the ceiling being fitted under the hatchways on the vessel's arrival in India. Notations of Lloyd's A & C.P., SLMC 7,40, F.D., C.L. have also been assigned. It is concluded the spacing of the rivets in the side frames amidships is $5\frac{3}{4}$ " as approved, and that the length of the forecastle for record in the Register Book in accordance with Circular 1551 is 43 feet, but I shall be glad to learn whether this is so. I think it well to point out that from the particulars given in your report the nominal horse power of this vessel should be 669 and not 640, and you should, therefore, render an additional account for the difference of £1,9.0.

"ROSSUM" With reference to my letter of the 19th ultimo, I think it well to acquaint you that in view of a report now received from the Barry Surveyors the Committee have today agreed to the proposal to complete the Special Survey No.3 of this vessel sometime within the Year of Grace allowed by the Society's Rules. A copy of a letter which has today been addressed to the Managers of this vessel is sent herewith for your information.
