This certificate is issued under the authority of the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

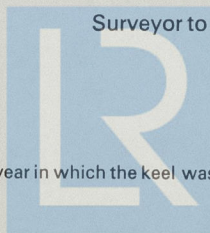
