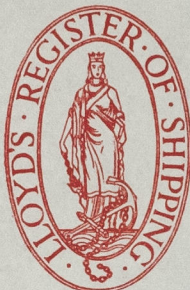

**This is to Certify** *that I have surveyed part of the machinery of the S.S. "DEXAGO GLASGOW" 11847 gross tons of LONDON (EX. "GAINTRY LIVERPOOL") for Main Boiler Survey, Tailshaft Survey, Continuous Survey of Machinery and Condition of Class whilst afloat and in dry dock at Singapore on the 18th November 1967 and subsequently, and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following survey records assigned* MBS 11/67, TS(OL) 11/67 now, and OSM (with date) *when the survey has been completed, without condition regarding the main inlet valve chest but subject to any outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.*
