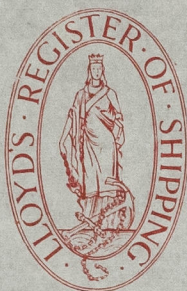


LLOYD'S REGISTER OF SHIPPING

for Part Continuous Survey of Machinery and Damage, stated to have been
caused by grounding and refloating operations at Moreton Bay on the 23rd
24th June, 1965,
and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I
am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register
of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following
survey records assigned CSM (with date) when the survey has been completed,
subject to all outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously
recommended.
