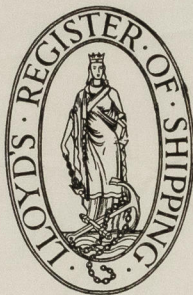

This is to Certify that

EDGAR WATSON

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners' Representatives, survey the starboard furnace of the Port Main Boiler of the S.S. "SALAMMANNA" 2780 tons of Monrovia, it being reported that the Port Main Boiler was examined in Alexandria, in December 1963, and a certificate was issued subject to the starboard furnace of the Port Main Boiler being examined in February 1964.

The starboard furnace was examined at Kingston, Jamaica, on the 10th August 1964, and the furnace was trammelled at each corrugation, and it is the opinion of the undersigned, that, so far as the starboard furnace of the Port Main Boiler is concerned, the vessel is in a fit condition to proceed on the intended voyage to Sweden, with the recommendation that the starboard furnace of the Port Main Boiler be further examined, at the port of discharge, at the end of the present voyage.
