This ship has been sold to British Iron & Steel Corporation and allocated to shipbreakers for breaking up at Dunston, where she has now arrived.

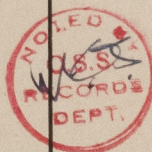

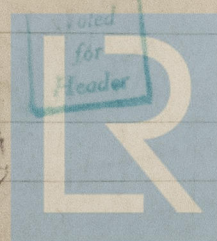
