Work done: Vessel placed in dry dock bottom rudder under-water surfaces cleaned, examined, placed in good condition and recoated.

Cathode protection was fitted to the vessel at this dry docking.

Steering gear and windlass examined under working conditions and found in good order.

Anchor cables ranged and cable anchors and all shackles examined as per rule requirements, and found in good order. (Owners' request this item be taken as part Special Survey).

Annual Load Line Survey carried out.

Repairs: 7 rivets renewed in Port side of hull plating and 6 rivets renewed in Port side No. 1 hold.
