The turbines and gearing have been constructed under the supervision of the British Corporation and a certificate forwarded.

As in the case of the sister vessel "EMPIRE CHIEFTAIN" the working pressure of the main boilers has been increased beyond that originally approved in order that the designed power may be reached. This alteration was approved in an endorsement dated 11.11.43.

This vessel's machinery appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, ^{& specification} and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed LMC * 2.46
