In reply to your classing letter dated 27th February, 1953 we beg to inform you that it was originally intended that the Owners would supply 30 K.W. generators as mentioned on the approved plan dated 1st October, 1952.

After the generators had been received, we found, however, that the generators were 40 K.W. (as mentioned in our report). The cables and switchgear have been made in accordance with nominal rating current of the generators, however, the electrical contractors could not supply circuit breakers as required in the Society's Rules.

Since the maximum capacity required for this equipment is only 15 up to 20 K.W. we may give you into consideration to accept D.P. fuses and D.P. switches in this case.

We beg your pardon for the wrong reference in our report.

We send herewith the revised plan 'as fitted'.
