Referring to our letter of yesterday regarding the above ship we think it well to refer the following letter received from the owners to-day, viz.:-


"With further reference to correspondence regarding the transfer of the above ship from Lloyd's to Norske Veritas class, we beg to inform you that this is partly due to the contracts we have made with the same yard for conversion of two ships, one of which already being classed with Norske Veritas. The contracts for these two ships were in their turn based on another conversion according to N.V. rules, and it appeared that the requirements of the classification societies differed to a very great extent.

We may further also mention that there has been a certain tendency to transfer ships to Norske Veritas class, especially during the latter years."

RE: VERITAS.

Referring to our letter of yesterday re-
ferring to the above ship we think it will be better to
reply to your letter received from the same date, viz. 1-7-55.

With further reference to correspondence
regarding the ownership of the above ship from
1947 to 1954, we have to inform
you that this is partly due to the fact that we
have not yet received the necessary information
from the authorities in Norway, one of which is
the Norwegian Maritime Administration. The documents
in their possession on the subject of the ship's
ownership are not yet available. We are, however,
of the opinion that the results of the investigation
will be a very great help.

We may further add that there has been
a certain tendency to transfer ships to other
classes, especially during the last years.
