**NEW FOREPART FOR TANKER  
"PICARDIE"**

Commenting on a report from Sunderland that Messrs. Olsen & Ugelstad, Oslo, have cancelled an order given to John Crown & Sons, Ltd., for the construction of a new forepart for the tanker *Picardie*, the "Norges Handels og Sjøfartstidende" states that it was Mr. Olav Ringdal, of Oslo, and not Messrs. Olsen & Ugelstad, who bought the afterpart of the *Picardie*. This is being towed to the Kiel yard of Howaldtswerke A.G. The Oslo paper adds that Howaldtswerke are at present completing a motorship of 12,300 tons d.w., which has been bought by Mr. I. M. Skaugen, of Oslo, and has been named *Skaugum*. The vessel, which will have accommodation for 12 passengers and a speed of about 18 knots in loaded condition, is due for delivery in February, 1949.
