

CERTIFICATE FOR ENGINES AND BOILERS


This is to Certify that the Engines and Boilers of the
Steam Tanker "ESSO WANDSWORTH"
4352 Tons, of London
Built at Duluth, Minnesota in 1943
have been surveyed at South Shields
in June 1957
by the Surveyors to this Society, and reported to be in good and safe
working condition, at a pressure of 180 lb. per square inch on
the main boilers. The approved working pressure of the donkey boiler
is - lb. per square inch.

The survey having been completed, the Record LMC (Lloyd's
Machinery Certificate) has been made in the Register Book, subject to
Periodical Surveys as required by the Rules.
