ALTERATIONS TO CONDITIONS OF ASSIGNMENT OF LOADLINES

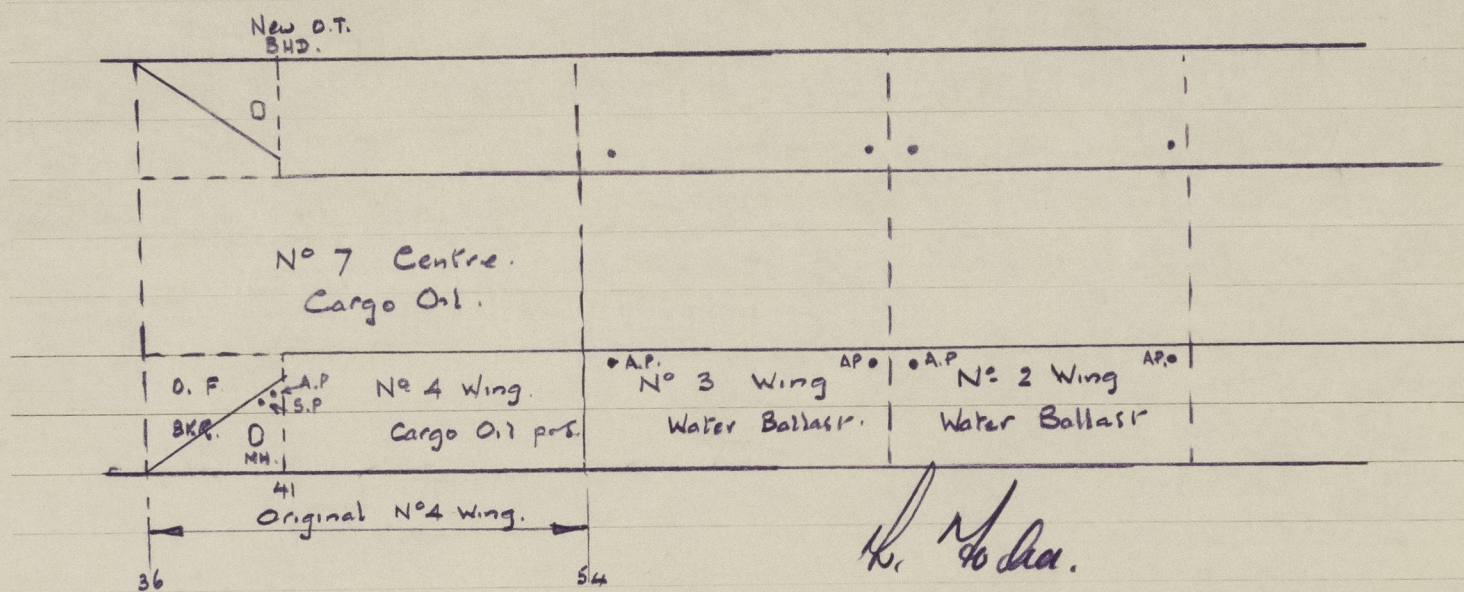

This ship has been under survey at South Shields

on July 1959 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/found:—

Effected Steel O.T. bulkheads fitted P & S on frame 41 forming 1 additional wing tank p & s. frs. 41-54 for the carriage of cargo oil 25½ x 19½" access manholes cut in freeboard deck closed by steel O.T. covers with 6 toggles. Air pipe for No.4 wing tank repositioned and stayed to Poop Front. New 2½" S.P. with screwed cap stayed to poop front. Gas relief pipe fitted to No.4 wing tank coaming.

Found. Nos. 2 & 3 wing tanks converted from cargo oil to water ballast, cargo oil lines blanked off 2 - 4" air pipes fitted to each tank, openings 7'6" above freeboard deck efficiently stayed to trunk, closed by wood plugs and canvas covers.
