Dear Sirs,

Reverting to your letter of the 21st April 1926 respecting the case of Messrs. Chantier de Penhoet Yard No. U5, I now have the pleasure to enclose a memorandum setting forth the freeboards which have been provisionally assigned to this vessel, subject to the particulars and dimensions now supplied being verified on completion, to the usual covers being fitted to the openings in the steel 'tween deck bulkheads in way of the tonnage opening, and to efficient temporary covers being provided for closing the tonnage opening in the superstructure deck.

The freeboards have been computed on a corrected tonnage coefficient of .74 and are subject to alteration if found necessary.
