

The markings are welded on main deck stringer and embossed brass plates set in wood deck on the poop as sample shown:-



The figures above the line in way of main deck give the distance from top of main sheer strake to centre of opening, and in way of poop deck, distance from top of poop sheer strake to centre of opening.

The figures below the line give the size of the opening.
