Dear Sirs,

H. I have to acquaint you I am in receipt of a report from the Society's Surveyors at Buenos Aires on the refrigerating machinery and appliances of the motor vessel "TIRADENTES" from which it appears that the after auxiliary engine has badly broken down and they recommend that this engine should be repaired on the vessel's return to a home port.

It is observed from the shipping papers that the vessel left Buenos Aires on the 1st instant for Hamburg and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know when and at what port an opportunity will be afforded for the above matter to receive the necessary attention.

At the same time I have to inform you that the anchor, referred to in your report No. 2454 on this vessel, still requires to be examined and the marks compared with the certificate of test and found in order.
