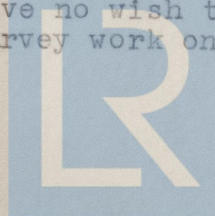
ANSWER

With reference to the entry in the Special Reasons List, I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Owners and let me know what arrangements they propose making for the examination of the A.P. tank top.

I shall also be glad to learn the Owners' intentions regarding the carrying out of the Donkey Boiler Survey which became due at the end of last month.

Date:— 12th December, 1955.

The Owners state that the vessel has been sold to the British Ministry of Transport. She is at present loading a cargo of grain at Bahia Blanca and is expected to arrive in Bremen about the 20th of January, and is to be delivered to the British Ministry at a Port of the U.K. some time towards the end of January. As the vessel has been sold "as she stands" Messrs. Vogemann have no wish to carry out any further survey work on this ship.
