The undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners and Agents, survey the steel screw Motorship "WIRADENTES" of gross Tonsberg, for alterations to the conditions of loading as prescribed by the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

The following alterations have now been completed satisfactorily:-

The overboard scupper draining shelter 'tween deck permanently covered by cover plates electrically welded to shell plating.

The freeing ports in tonnage well permanently closed by electric shutters to shell plating.

Two scuppers fitted each side in shelter 'tween deck, draining to space bilges.

A substantial automatic screw-down non-return valve fitted each side in tonnage well, draining overboard and controlled from shelter extension spindles.

A new Load Line Certificate with endorsement for deeper loading, issued at London on the 4th November 1942, has been placed on board the ship.
