I have to report that I have surveyed the M.S.

his date.

I have compared the arrangements on board the ship with International Convention Requirements ~~as given in the original freeboard report~~ and I have found them to be in agreement therewith or equivalent thereto, and the whole to be in efficient condition.

Vessel surveyed afloat and in dry dock with a view to extending the Load Line Certificate until a General Examination can be made. Part of a Special Survey carried out at this time.

Alterations have taken place in the hull or superstructures which will affect the calculation of freeboards.

It is recommended that the Load Line Certificate be renewed until the 31st August 1943 to coincide with the expiry of the year of grace. The present Load Line Certificate and Certified Copy (which expires on 4/9/42) have been endorsed "The provisions of the Convention being complied with by this ship, this Certificate is renewed till August 1943."

The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. ---- dated 15th September 1937. This is returned herewith.
