and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all ^{temporary} repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she be continued as now classed without fresh record of drydocking subject to stem bar and adjacent plating (2nd and 3rd strakes below sheer P & S) and framing in way being permanently repaired at next drydocking and to all outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.
