On the 30th July last, a proposal to maintain the class until the 1st February, 1966 was approved subject to the vessel being generally examined, the extent of the inspection being left to the Surveyor's discretion. With regard to the machinery, some main bearings of the port main engine require examination at the same time for advancement of the Continuous Survey cycle.

There is a condition of class requiring that the port aft auxiliary engine scavenge pump bottle guide jacket be examined by the end of September, 1965, which will also require attention at the General Examination.

I confirm the telephone conversation which took place this morning, when it was requested that the case be given the necessary attention.
