Motorship "DURHAM"

I have your letter of the 27th instant, and have today informed the Committee of the position.

In reply, I am pleased to say that provided the vessel is generally examined next October, and found or placed in a satisfactory condition, the Committee will be prepared to maintain the ship in class until 1st February, 1966. The extent of the General Examination will be left to the discretion of the Surveyor undertaking the inspection.

With regard to the machinery I would point out that no main bearings of the port main engine appear to have been seen for over four years, and it is considered that some of these should receive attention in conjunction with the General Examination.

It is concluded you will also require a Short Term Loadline Certificate to cover the ship until 1st February, 1966, and that certificate will be issued by our Surveyors on completion of the Loadline Renewal Survey.
