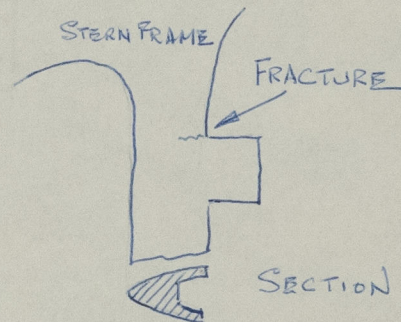
Rudder removed for renewal of bearing pad & withdrawal of shaft.
