I acknowledge your cablegram of the 29th ultimo and in reply would inform you that while there is no objection to your complying with Mr. Cowasjee's request, this now seems to have been superseded by a further application which has been received from the Esplen Trust Ltd., who are apparently the Owners of the hulk.

They have asked for you to be authorised to issue a Damage Report giving your recommendations for reclassification, such report to be released to Mr. N.F. Cowasjee whom you have probably already met. For this it will be necessary for both the hull and machinery to be surveyed.

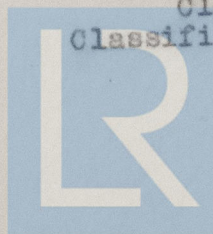
In view of the extensive damage which has been sustained by this craft, it has been considered desirable to request the Principal Surveyor for Italy to arrange for you to be joined in your inspection of the hull by a Senior Ship Surveyor; and I have cabled to Mr. Boylan on this point. You will doubtless be hearing from him on the subject within a short time.

It will be appreciated if you will kindly keep this Office advised of any developments.
