A general examination was commenced on the S.S. "BANNSPUR" at Glasgow at the end of August and recommendations for repairs were made by the Surveyor.

The Owners thereupon decided to lay up the ship for an indefinite period until they had made up their minds about the future of the ship.

They have advised me this morning that they are scrapping the ship and, in fact, delivered the vessel to the brokers yard in Dublin this week-end.

In the circumstances I have asked them to return the Freeboard Certificates for cancellation and doubtless you will make a suitable entry in the Register Book.
