In reference to your letter of August 19th regarding the above named vessel, I have to report that the oil engine driving the 75 K.W. generator was a stock engine built by the Sun Shipbuilding and Dry Dock Company, Chester, Pa., under the supervision of the American Bureau of Shipping. Attached please find copy of the test results of the main forgings entering into the construction of the engine, as taken from the records of the American Bureau of Shipping.

Satisfactory arrangements have been made with the Sun Shipbuilding & Dry Dock Company, for obtaining copies of test results of motors used for essential service at sea in full future cases.

Both the "AMERICA SUN" and the "ATLANTIC SUN", are fitted with 4" direct bilge suction in addition to the 1 1/4".
