

MOTOR TANKER "AMERICAN SUN"

PHILADELPHIA REPORT 7969

It is apparent from the correspondence that the Philadelphia and the New York Surveyors are confusing the Rules for Electric Motors with those for Heavy Oil Engines Section 2, Clause 41.

IT IS SUBMITTED they be informed that although the 75 KW generator does not require to be surveyed during construction, being under 100 KW, this does not apply to the engine driving it as this comes under Section 2, Clause 41 of the Rules for the Construction of Heavy Oil Engines and Auxiliaries. It will appear that the Surveyors, although acquainted with the portion of the Rule which relieves them of the necessity of surveying the 75 KW generator, have overlooked that portion requiring their action *by* the submission of Test Certificates for this generator.

With reference to the Test Certificates for motors for auxiliary purposes, it is noted from the G.E.C. letter of the 29th April that the Purchasers did not inform them that Certificates would be required.

It is noted the Philadelphia Surveyors have ^{now} been instructed to inform the Sun Shipbuilding & Dry Dock Co. of the Society's requirements and it is concluded satisfactory arrangements will be made in future.

IT IS FURTHER SUBMITTED the electrical installation be accepted.
