The report on the turbo generating sets states that due to an oversight on the part of the Sun Shipbuilding Co. the two generating sets were not built under Special Survey as required by the Rules, but they were built under Special Survey of the American Bureau, and meet all the requirements of that Society and of the American Government. They have been tried under working conditions and found satisfactory, and it is considered they might be accepted in this instance.

It is submitted the New York Surveyors be informed accordingly, and that in order to prevent lapses of this description in the United Kingdom the builders' attention is drawn to the requirements by means of an endorsement on the plans:-

Generators of 100 K.W. and over and Motors of 100 B.H.P. and over are to be inspected by the Surveyors during manufacture and testing. The shipbuilder should notify the suppliers accordingly.
